Early Childhood Teachers as Key Workers

Our early childhood teachers are qualified early childhood professionals who work as Key Workers to support you from across home, clinic and early childhood settings. They are your main point of contact and work alongside you and your family to help your child achieve their NDIS goals.

Our early childhood teachers have expertise in child development, learning, social-emotional well-being and can support language and gross and fine motor skill development using low risk strategies. They build on your child's everyday routines, interests and strengths to create meaningful learning and developmental opportunities.

As key workers, our team collaborates with your child's early childhood educators and/or school staff to support their play, learning and development within their natural environments.

Our early childhood teachers provide a unique perspective as they have experience in cultivating safe environments for children to learn and become more independent whilst also supporting you and your family to gain skills and confidence in supporting and advocating for your child.

Our early childhood teachers as key workers can support you by:

- Connecting you with the right services and supports.
- Implementing low-risk strategies to support language development.
- Implementing low-risk strategies to support fine and gross motor development.
- Implementing low-risk strategies to encourage sensory exploration.
- Supporting you to access and arrange appointments with allied health professionals.
- Working with allied health professionals to reinforce strategies in key worker therapeutic sessions.
- Coordinating services so that the team is working together to achieve your child's goals.
- Advocating for you and your family and supporting transition to formal education settings.
